[4] (b) Give an account of the aspects of religious life that were kept and adapted when the Arabs became Muslims. (c) To what extent is the story of Ibrahim a focus of pilgrimage (Hajj) today? Give reasons to support your answer. [6] [Total: 20] Section B: Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) 3 (a) Describe the people's reaction when the Prophet (pbuh) first preached at Safa. [4] (b) In what ways was the tribal clan system both a means of protection and a source of danger to Muhammad (pbuh)?
